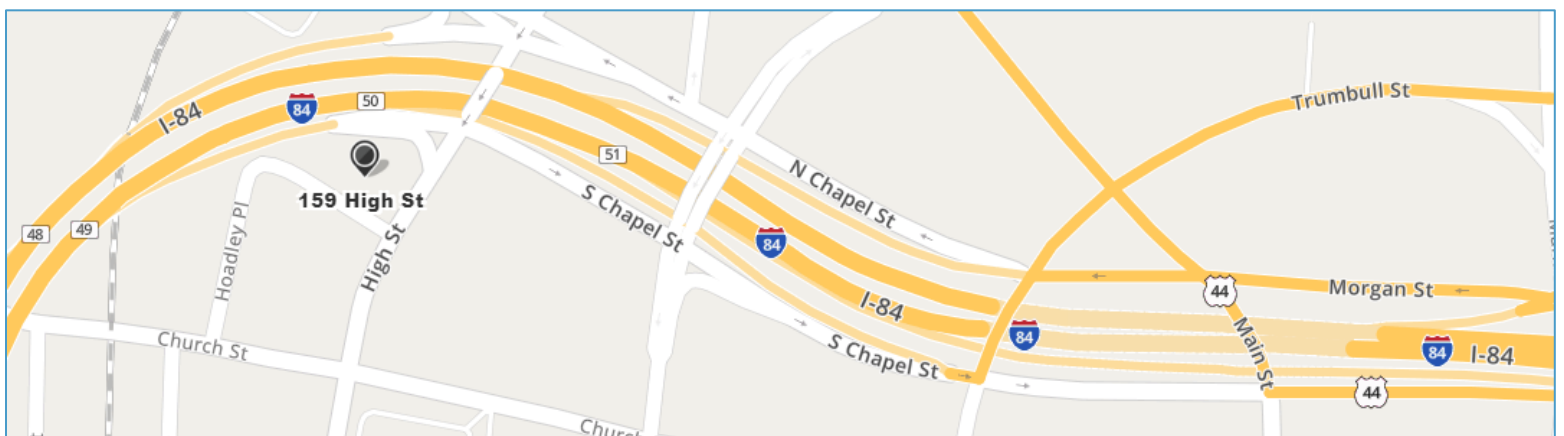

Location: 159 High St. Hartford, CT 06114

I-84 E to Hartford, Take EXIT 49 to Ann Uccello St, Turn right onto High St.

I-84 W to Hartford, Take EXIT 50, to Main St/I-91 S, Stay straight to Morgan St.

Continue to follow Morgan St., Turn slight right onto N Chapel St.,

Keep left at the fork to continue on N Chapel St., Turn left onto High St.
