

DAR / C.A.R. LIAISON COMMITTEE Report

DAR

Connecticut DAR members have referred a total of 122 approved applicants to the SAR since we started tracking their referrals in 2009.

When a DAR member refers three (3) or more approved applicants to the SAR, she is awarded the SAR Medal of Appreciation. Since 2009, CTSSAR has awarded 14 SAR Medals of Appreciation to DAR members.

When a DAR member refers ten (10) or more approved applicants to the SAR, she is awarded the SAR Martha Washington Medal. Since 2009, CTSSAR has awarded 3 SAR Martha Washington Medals to DAR members.

DAR member, Sara Champion was awarded the SAR Martha Washington Medal in 2017. Three more of her referrals were approved at NSSAR in 2018. She now has referred a total of 13 approved applicants. Sara is running a close second to DAR member Marilyn Davis, who has referred a total of 16 approved applicants.



C.A.R.

Connecticut SAR, has donated \$50 to the Connecticut Society Children of the American Revolution (C.S.C.A.R.) for their 2018-2019 State Project "Soar the Skies with C.S.C.A.R." C.S.C.A.R. raised \$4,000 and donated it to A Place Called Hope in Killingworth, and Horizon Wings in Ashford. Both organizations are rehabilitation centers for birds of prey.

On March 19th, I filed the proper year-end report with the NSSAR C.A.R. Liaison Committee Chairman – well before the April 1st deadline – and the NSSAR C.A.R. Liaison Committee Chairman has confirmed that he has received it. We will, once again, receive the N.S.C.A.R. Activity Streamer at the 2019 SAR Congress.
