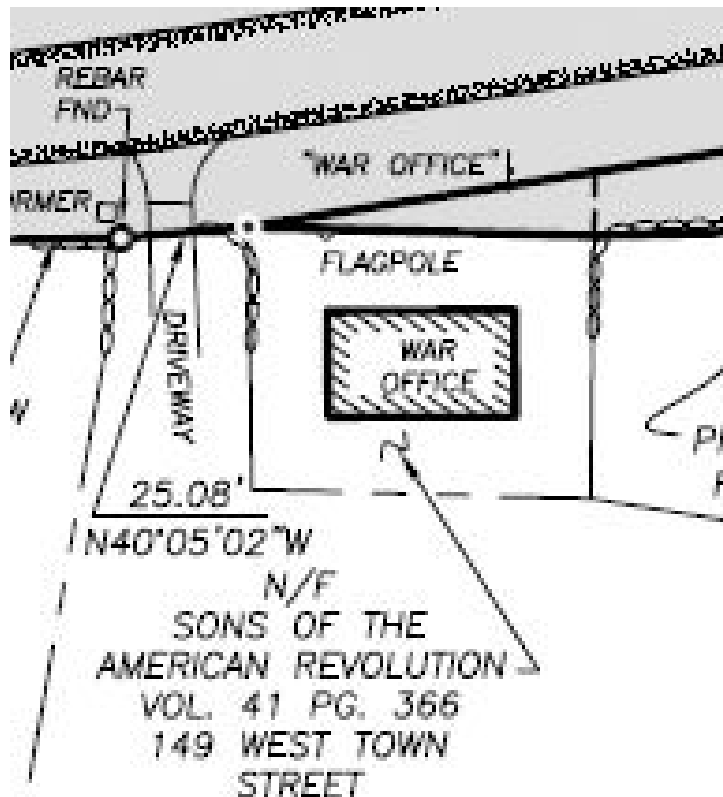

RE: Civil Summons; The Lebanon Historical Society vs Sons of the American Revolution

As Secretary for the CTSSAR, I accepted a Civil Summons on behalf of the CTSSAR for the above noted action. I've reviewed the action with our President, Chancellor, Trustee, The Properties Committee, and made a presentation to CTSSAR members present and the Color Guard meeting on February 16, 2019.

This case was negotiated over a two-year period between the Attorney Generals Office, The town of Lebanon, The Adams Trumbull Fund, The Historical Society, and the First Congregational Church. It clears up the Town of Lebanon's title to the Lebanon Green, places historic easements on the green, and provides additional land to several abutters with an historic easement.

Please refer to the map below of the War Office. The shaded triangle between the War Office property and the street will be quick claimed to the CTSSAR with historic easements.



The following is a synopsis of the actions taken in this Civil Suit on behalf of the CTSSAR.

1. Civil Summons was accepted by the Secretary on January 18, 2019
2. The Secretary mailed a copy to the Chancellor
3. The Secretary informed and discussed the action with the parties noted
4. The Secretary reviewed the case with the Attorney Generals Office (first defendant), and the Attorney for the plaintiff and received background information on the case
5. The Secretary spoke with the Historical Societies representative (the plaintiff), who was referred to him by the Attorney for the Adams Trumbull Fund the (second defendant)
6. The Secretary briefed the Chancellor on his discussions with the plaintiffs and defendants
7. The Secretary presented his findings to the Properties Committee and CTSSAR members in attendance at the Color Guard meeting
8. The Chancellor submitted the proper appearance documentation on February 19, 2019 as required

The Chancellor and I will continue to monitor the case and provide updates to the Board of Managers.
